<p>INSURANCE PROVISIONS</p> <p>INSTRUCTOR INSURANCE</p> <p>Northstowe Karatae Club always ensures that all instructors are fully insured. A copy of any relevant insurance documentation is available on request or may be viewed online via BMABA.org/verify</p>
<p>DBS CHECK STATUS</p> <p>Northstowe Karate Club teaches adults and children and so all instructors hold an enhanced disclosure which has been deemed to be acceptable. Evidence of this check may be provided on request or is available at BMABA.org/verify</p>
<p>INSTRUCTOR GRADE REQUIREMENTS</p> <p>Northstowe Karate Club always ensures that our instructors are qualified to or above the minimum standard expected by our association. This is Shodan.</p>
<p>FIRST AID STATUS</p> <p>Northstowe Karate Club takes the safety of its members seriously. All instructors are first aid trained to an acceptable standard and sufficient emergency first aid equipment is present at all classes and on site at all times. A risk assessment and associated health and safety briefs are conducted prior to classes commencing.</p>

Northstowe Karate Club takes its responsibilities to run a professional class seriously. Accordingly, we are registered with JSKE and JKA. Any associated membership certification is available on request.

FEES & CHARGES

Northstowe Karate Club does not have any hidden costs or dishonest fee collections in place. All money is payable by bank transfer when due. Our club charges a £35 registration fee to include association membership and insurance and this is payable after 4 sessions of training with us. This fee is payable only once a year.

Classes are charged at variable rates depending on the class type, however our standard class fee is £4/3 adults/juniors. Please check any rates or charges before committing to training encase this has changed.

You are NOT bound by any contract and may discontinue training at any time.

INDEPEDENCE STATUS

Northstowe Karate Club is associated with a professional association to ensure our standards are some of the highest available, however we remain legally independent and are not submitted to any compulsory regulation or obligation under any of the above named associations.

Accordingly, it is our club's responsibility to comply with local and national laws / regulations, and there is no re-course to our representing organisation in the event of any breach of law, regulation or protocol. We retain the right to be an independent club and govern ourselves by best practice whether we are inside or outside the membership / affiliation of any above named governing bodies.

REPORTING OUR CLUB
